

## A.1 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR MEDICINE 14 / 15

### NOTES:

- APP = Applications Per Place. APP may be 2-3x **higher** for overseas students than for home and EU students.
- PBL = Problem Based Learning
- SSC = Student Selected Components
- In general if GCSE English Language is not offered then a student will need to achieve at least 7.0 in IELTS (or equiv)
- All Universities will accept double award science at GCSE
- Often Maths and Further Maths at A/AS level are not considered separate – please check.
- General Studies and Critical thinking are usually not accepted
- See notes on types of medical course to understand ‘Integrated’, ‘PBL’, Systems based’ etc.
- If re-sits are accepted then there are usually caveats associated – please check with the relevant admissions office
- There is usually specific advice on the specific interview procedure of each university on their website – please read before you go!
  
- St Andrews is Pre-clinical only (first 3 years) – following this you move either to Manchester or elsewhere in Scotland for the Clinical phase
- Kings College is Guys and Thomas’s Hospital; Queen Mary is Barts and the London Hospital; UCL is Royal Free Hospital
- Peninsula is a partnership between the University of Plymouth and the University of Exeter

### **B.1 FOUNDATION COURSES FOR MEDICINE 2014 / 2015**

- Designed to widen access to students with non-science A levels or those from less privileged backgrounds.
- A one-year foundation program of study which then filters into the normal medical degree. These courses usually amalgamate with a full medical degree to constitute a 6yr course.
- Don't confuse this type of course with other 'foundation' courses e.g. (1) entry level access courses offered to students who may need a further year of study before being qualified to enter medical school (see next page) or (2) the NHS Foundation Programme; a two-year training programme for UK medical school **graduates**.
