3) FEES

Each course includes 15 hours of tuition except A level Computer Science, Politics, Psychology and GCSE Science, which count as two courses and require 30 hours of tuition. Each 15-hour course costs £575, and 30-hour A level courses and GCSE Science cost £1150. A level Maths and Further Maths are run as modules and cost £575 per module. Fees must be received in advance to secure a place on the course.

4) INDIVIDUAL TUITION

We offer individual tuition for either blocks of 10 or 15 hours per week, with lessons on each day of the week. Each block must be for one subject only. Tuition is charged at £100 per hour.
