

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Ashbourne is an academically demanding private college in London that selects students after interview and academic assessments. However, the process is friendly, informal and focuses on providing each applicant with the best available advice on all options at A level, without obligation. All prospective students are either interviewed by the Principal or a senior member of staff.

TUITION FEES

Our yearly fees is around £31,000 for 3 to 4 A level subjects (includes tuition for all subjects, exam fees, registration fee, a refundable book deposit and a weekly 2 hour personal tutor session). We offer partial scholarships of 10% - 50% dependent on the students' previous results (students are expected to achieve A*/A grades), school reports, tests and interview. The tuition fees would still be at least £16,000 per annum after.

ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS

While Ashbourne is not a boarding school, we provide a selection of accommodation options to any of our students. We have a choice of both student residences and host families. For the past 25 years, our students have been staying at the following accommodation and they always have positive feedback. Each student need to budget at least £13,000 for accommodation and living expenses in London.
